SONG is looking for a part-time Communications Fellow to join our 2018 SONG Fellowship cohort. The fellow will work closely with SONG's Communication Associates to develop the Fellow's leadership, to learn strategic communications skills and to build communications infrastructure within the organization.

What you would do as a SONG Communications Fellow:

- Execute and help carry out SONG's 2018-2019 Communications Plan
- Assist in the building and recruiting for *DigiCommz* (Regional Communications Infrastructure Team)
 - Looking throughout the base for members specializing in specific skills
 - Developing leadership and skills of *DigiCommz* members
 - Assist in executing member-led communications tasks and strategies
- Co-develop content for SONG platforms (could include day-to-day content, rapid response, updating materials and support for long-standing pieces for infrastructure)
- Support Communications Associates in media relations (includes follow-up, sending pitches or media tracking)
- Maintain SONG social media platforms and infrastructure
- Attend and support documentation for SONG convenings (includes but not limited to social media, notetaking and photography)
- Be open to learning facilitation skills, campaign development and developing relationships with SONG members, supporters and sister organizations.

What we are looking for in you:

- Strong writing skills
- Understanding of how to utilize social media: Instagram, Facebook, & Twitter
- Positive attitude and good communication skills
- Willingness to build relationships and community
- Strong demonstrated work ethic
- Good and demonstrated follow-through and initiative
- Ability to work independently
- Eye for design and attention to detail
- Eagerness to learn

 - Includes Organizing and Development Fellows
- Connection and leadership development with other LGBTQ folks building, organizing and learning across the South



- Opportunities for facilitation, direct action, event planning and community organizing trainings
- \$15/hour plus a cell phone stipend
- Length of contract will be 1 year
- 15-20 hours a week based on your availability, capacity, other work, number of fellows etc.
